- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.
- 2. Everyone stood for the Pledge to the Flag.
- 3. Upon roll call, the following Trustees were present: Harn, Carter, Mariscal, Reichert, and Fuller. Trustee Cumming was absent.
- 4. Minutes: Trustee Reichert moved to approve the minutes for December 15, 2015. Trustee Fuller seconded the motion, which was approved by a vote of 5-0.
