- 1. Call to Order: the meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.

- 4. Minutes: Trustee Harn moved to approve the minutes of July 21, 2015. Trustee Fuller seconded the motion, which was approved by a vote of 5-0.

Public Works: Trustee Harn had nothing to report

Trustee Harn moved to approve the inspection of Well#11 by the Cahoy Group for \$10,022. Trustee Carter seconded the motion, which was approved by a vote of 5-0.
