

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE
THE PRODUCING OR REPRODUCING
OF OFFENSIVE SOUND OR NOISE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF PEORIA HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: That no person shall allow or cause to be used or operated any radio, musical instrument, sound amplifier or other device or machine for the producing or reproducing of sound in such a manner as to disturb the peace, quite and comfort of the neighboring inhabitants or at any time with louder volume than is necessary for convenient hearing for the person who is in the room, vehicle or chamber in which such machine or device is operated and who is a voluntary listener thereto. The operation of any such machine or device between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of 50 feet from the building, structure or vehicle in which it is located shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO: That any person found in violation of this Ordinance, shall be fined upon conviction not less than SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) nor more than FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for each offense. Each day an offense is committed shall constitute a separate offense.

That after receipt of a complaint regarding the alleged violation of this Ordinance, the person so cited may settle the violation by making a payment of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) to the Village of Peoria Heights Police Department for each violation of this Ordinance at least SEVEN (7) calendar days prior to the Court appearance date so indicated on such complaint. Such settlement option shall not apply to the second and subsequent violation within any TWELVE (12) month period.

That the receipt of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) for each and every violation of this Ordinance so indicated in such complaint no later than SEVEN (7) calendar days prior to the Court appearance date shall terminate the Ordinance violation action and resolve all Village claims for fines against the alleged violator on the current complaint only.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
