ORDINANCE 2006-1270

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING OF VEHICLES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR THE STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF PEORIA HEIGHTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PEORIA HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORTION:

SECTION ONE: PARKING VEHICLES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

- No motor vehicles, watercraft, trailers, recreational vehicles or anything else of
 a vehicular nature may be parked in the front yard of any home or business.
 "Front Yard" shall be defined as that portion of the property even with and/or
 in front of the primary structure on the property. If no primary structure is
 located there, no vehicles can be parked there.
- No paved surface may be added to a front yard or backyard, subsequent to the
 date of this Ordinance being approved, without approval from the Village
 Administrator or his designee, the Code Enforcement Officer.

SECTION TWO: PARKING TRAILERS, BOATS OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON THE STREET.

No recreational vehicle may be parked on the street, unless it is of a temporary nature. No trailer, boat trailer or any vehicle, other than a passenger car, truck, van or the like, may be parked on the street, unless it is of a temporary nature. "Temporary Nature" shall be defined as a twenty-four (24) hour period, and no more than one (1) twenty-four (24) hour period per week. In the event that such above-named vehicle would require to be parked on the street for longer than a twenty-four (24) hour period, it will still be considered as "temporary". A one-time permit for twenty-five (\$25) dollars can be obtained for such temporary period, not to exceed two (2) weeks, after review by the Code Enforcement Officer and/or the Village Administrator.

SECTION THREE: PENALTY

Any violations of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than sixty (\$60) dollars or no more than five hundred (\$500) dollars. Settlement payments may be made no later than fourteen (14) calendar days subsequent to the date the citation was issued. A Settlement payment of fifty (\$50) dollars may be made by paying the Settlement amount to the Village of Peoria Heights Police Department, 4901 N. Prospect Road, Peoria Heights, Illinois 61616.

If you fail to pay the Settlement amount within the required time, you shall be required to appear at the time and date set forth in the citation. If the recipient of a citation shall fail to appear at the time and place set forth in the notice and has failed to pay the Settlement amount, a Judgment of Guilty and fine and costs may be entered again the recipient who fails to appear in the Circuit Court or Peoria County, Illinois at the time, date and place set forth in the citation.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
